

2018 Platte City Plein Air Rules & Regulations

Artist Registration & Sign-In

- All artists MUST sign in and register on site prior to painting. At registration, artists MUST acknowledge the liability waiver; terms of the event use agreement and have supports stamped **before** beginning painting. Artists are required to sign in only once.

- All artists will be issued an artist name tag, lanyard & event t-shirt at sign-in. Artists must have your name tag AT ALL TIMES when painting in the area.

- Artist registration & opening reception sign-in, and support stamping will be: Friday, June 1, 2018 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Followed by the Artists' Opening Reception from 6:00-8:00 p.m. at Cohen's Art & Framing, 319 Main Street, Platte City, MO 64079

- If you are unable to register on Friday, June 1, 2018, you may make arrangements to register or stamp additional supports the week of May 28th - May 31st at Cohen's Art & Framing, 319 Main Street, Platte City, MO. 64079

- Pamella Lehman will also be able to stamp additional supports for the Quick Paint events on Saturday, June 2nd before 12 noon at Cohen's Art & Framing.

- Artists shall be provided three (3) submission forms at registration and sign-in for use in submitting paintings for competition. Each artist may submit up to three paintings for judging at the conclusion of the event at Cohen's Art & Framing.

Only Stamped Supports Can Be Used in the Event

- Each Artist registration fee entitles the artist to have an unlimited number of stamped supports.

- Artists may only use stamped supports while painting in Platte City Plein Air, including the Quick Paint competitions, and paintings submitted for judging and awards.

\$100 Quick Paint Events:

- **Participation in all Quick Paint events is included with the event registration.**

- **Two individual Quick Paint events will be held, weather permitting:**

- **Saturday, June 2nd, 1:00 p.m. -3:00 p.m. – Settler's Crossing Park at the end of Main Street, Platte City, MO**

- **Saturday, June 2nd, 4:00-6:00 p.m., Platte City Courthouse Lawn, Main Street, Platte City, MO**

- **Artists participating in the Quick Paint events MUST submit their painting for judging immediately after the completion of time for that Quick Paint event.**

- **The winning artist agrees to frame their Quick Paint painting and deliver it to Cohen's Art & Framing for auction at the Awards Ceremony in return for the \$100 purchase award.**

Plein Air Competition Submissions:

a. All paintings submitted for judging for this event must be created ENTIRELY and WHOLLY on site at Settler's Crossing Park and Platte City courthouse during the period of the event, June 2, 2018.

- No studio work is allowed on any paintings submitted for judging. Any paintings deemed to be constructed entirely or in part off-site will NOT be eligible for judging or any awards.

- All Paintings submitted for auction **must be delivered on June 3, 2018 between 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.** to: **Cohen's Art & Framing**, 319 Main Street, Platte City, Missouri 64079

- Each artist may submit up to three (3) paintings for consideration. Each painting submitted must be stamped and have a completed artist submission form securely attached to the back of each painting. Submission forms will be provided to the artist at sign-in with their registration material.

- Artists must deliver all paintings for auction **ready to hang**, as set forth on the Proper Hanging instructions provided by Cohen's Art & Framing and included in the welcome package in these rules. The registration stamp on the painting support must be visible when the painting is submitted for judging. If necessary, please cut a small window so that the stamp on the support is visible. Artists submitting pieces for judging should consider the quality of the framing and finishing because selected works will be displayed for sale to the public.

- Artists will be issued submission receipts, identifying their paintings. Artist **must retain these receipts** for collection of their work at the conclusion of the event.

- Artwork will be auctioned on June 8th, Platte City Plein Air opening exhibit.

Display and Sale of Paintings at Cohen's Art & Framing

- All art submitted for judging is eligible for consideration to be displayed and sold at Cohen's Art & Framing.

- Plein Air Art chosen for display at Cohen's Art & framing shall be selected at the sole discretion of the Plein Air Selection Committee and Juror.
- If selected for display and sale, the Artist must leave paintings for display and sale until the conclusion of the Platte City Plein-Air Exhibit on June 29, 2018.
- Artists are encouraged to price their paintings to sell.
- For every painting sold, artists will receive 70% of the retail price with 30% of the retail price going to Cohen's Art & Framing. All sale proceeds will be delivered by check, mailed to the artist's contact address given at registration. Checks will be mailed within two weeks of the conclusion of the Platte City Plein Air Exhibit.
- Cohen's Art & Framing will collect and pay all sales taxes due. You must complete a W-9 form in order to receive payment for sold works totaling over \$600.00. Notification of payments over \$600.00 to artist for sold art will be reported to IRS as 1099 income.

Artist's Responsibility to Pick-Up Paintings Not Displayed or Purchased.

- If a submitted painting is not selected for display at Cohen's Art & Framing, it will need to be collected by the artist from Cohen's Art & Framing between the hours of 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday, June 6, 2018. Artists needing to pick up their painting during this period will be notified by email.
- If an artist's painting is selected for display, the artist agrees to leave the painting at Cohen's Art & Framing for the duration of the Platte City Plein Air Exhibit. If any painting has not been sold during the exhibit, the artist will be notified by email to collect the painting between the hours of 11 a.m. and 5 p.m., June 29, 2018.
- To collect paintings, the artist must tender a photo ID and the submission receipt issued to the artist when the painting was submitted for judging.

The following Friday, The Platte City Plein Air Awards Ceremony will be held at Cohen's Art & Framing from 6pm-8pm on June 8th. This will be the first original artwork created of our historic downtown. Our reception will include a silent art auction where all of the pieces of artwork created during the festival will be sold. This is a special chance to meet the talented artists, celebrate their work, and enjoy an evening of food and adult drinks with the your local community.
